III. Qualifications

1. New Admissions

- A. International students with both parents who are foreign nationals
(Exception: Taiwanese students with just one of the parents having foreign nationality may apply.)
- B. Must have completed (or must be expected to complete) at least 12 years of primary and secondary education at foreign or domestic institutions.
- C. The above curricula will be admissible only if they are in accordance with the standard national curriculum of either Korea or the corresponding country based on relevant legislation.

2. Transfer Admissions (3rd year)

- A. International students with both parents who are foreign nationals
(Exception: Taiwanese students with just one of the parents having foreign nationality may apply.)
- B. Students who have completed(or are expected to complete) at least 2 years of studies at formal four-year post-secondary institutions in Korea or in any other foreign countries, or those recognized as having equivalent academic background based on relevant legislations.
- C. Students who have completed, or are expected to complete, post-secondary education in Korea or in any other foreign countries, or those recognized as having equivalent academic background based on relevant legislation.
- D. Above academic background will only be accepted if they are regular education course based on Korean or Other nation's education legislation, and students with other education qualification(Such as 'General Equivalency Diploma' , 'Remote education course' , etc) may not apply.

3. Common matters

- A. If applicants and/or applicants' parents are dual national who acquired Korean nationality they will not be qualified.
- B. Acceptance and interpretation of academic qualifications are decided by decided by the 'Admissions Management Committee' of Sangmyung University.
- C. Applicants must had acquired overseas nationality prior to certain date.
 - New admission: Before entering high school
 - Transfer admission: 3 years before the admission application date

IV. Special Attention for Applicants

1. The applicant may only apply for one academic program.
2. Applicants may not be registered with other universities while registered with Sangmyung University. Tuition fees can be refunded according to Sangmyung regulations if they give up admission after tuition has been paid(Upon withdrawing before a semester begins, full tuition can be refunded. Upon withdrawing after a semester begins, a partial refund will be allowed according to Sangmyung regulations).
3. Applicants will be disqualified if considered to be unfit to study at the University, independent of the number of students to be admitted.
4. Among admitted students, those without TOPIK level III may be required to take additional Korean language courses recommended by Sangmyung University.
5. Admission will be revoked if it is proven that the student has been accepted through forgery, deception, or other actions of unlawfulness or dishonesty.
6. Admission will be cancelled if a visa is not issued from the Korean Government. All tuition will be refunded excluding the admission fee.
7. Applicant's name on the application form must be identical to that on the passport.
8. Applicants will be responsible for all disadvantages resulting from errors, omissions, or mistakes.

9. All application forms in any circumstances will not be returned after being submitted.
10. International students applying for recruitment on demand', except for those with both parents who are foreign nationals, should not apply for international admissions over six times(Including other schools). Admission will be cancelled if it is proven that the student has applied over six times for international admissions.
11. Please note that 'Application/Selection' schedule is different for 'Applicants in Korea' and 'Applicants overseas'
12. All international students are required to enroll in health insurance('National Health Insurance' or 'International Student Insurance') during their school year.
13. All international students must live in Dormitory for their first semester.
14. Sangmyung university collect a minimum personal information with the consent of the applicants at the time of application. Collected personal information is only used for 'Admission' and 'Academic administration' , and after the admission collected personal information is used for 'Education' , 'Administration' , 'Research' , etc.
 - ※ Personal information includes: name, alien registration number, application category, major, nationality, school, phone number, Email address, name of the guardian, phone number of the guardian, account number etc [kept for 10 years]

2. Dates of Application Submission
 - From October 11, 2018 (10:00) to November 1, 2018 (14:00)
 - ※ Off-line application submission (visiting in person) is available from 10:00 to 17:00 on weekdays during the reception period.
 - ※ Off-line application submission(by post) and on-line application(via E-mail) are only accepted if the arrival of documents at the 'Office of International relations' are before the deadline.
3. Matters for Attention Before Submitting Application
 - A. All items must be complete, and applicants are responsible for all disadvantages resulting from errors, omissions, or mistakes.
 - B. Cancellation or amendment of the application form is not possible once it has been submitted.
 - C. A digital self-portrait of file size no greater than 300kb is necessary before submission. (The 3.5cm x 4.5cm photo must be taken within 3 months of admission.)
 - D. All inquiries regarding the application submission and fee payment should be directed to Cheonan campus, International Student Services Team (041-550-5058).

3. About refund of application fee

2. Special attention about submitting application form

A. All applicants must submit the application form and related documents to the Cheonan campus, International Student Services Team (by postal service or visiting) prior to the deadline. (Submission by post or in-person both available)

Applicants may submit the certificate of academic verification and notarized family relation certificate (Chinese or English version) by the day of the written exam/interview (November 16, 2018)

B. Applicants with Certificates of Student Status, Graduation (expected), and Transcript issued in countries other than China should submit the “Apostille Confirmation” issued at the corresponding country-appointed governmental agency (Korea : the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade).

※ In case of countries that are not subject to the Apostille Agreement, the applicant should submit “Foreign Educational Institutional confirmation” or “consular confirmation” issued at the Korean consul in the country where corresponding schools are located.

C. Transfer applicants from combined five-year programs of high school and college in China must submit the certificate of academic verification issued by China Academic Degrees & Graduate Education Development Center (CDGDC, website : www.cdgdc.edu.cn) or China Higher Education Student Information and Career Center (CHESICC, website : www.chsi.com.cn), and their transcripts need to indicate separate curriculums of high school and college programs with the number of credits and hours on them.

D. Applicants from special schools different from typical high school system in China must submit the certificate of academic verification issued by CDGDC or CHESICC (must submit within the deadline)

E. Forms written in languages other than Korean, English or Chinese should be submitted with notarized Korean or English translation.

F. Original copy should be submitted for all documentary evidence. (With the exception of documents that are indicated to submit the copy form)

G. Applicants expected to graduate or expected to complete regular courses must additionally submit the original graduation certificate or attendance certificate before the beginning of the semester, or otherwise, admissions will be cancelled.

H. In case applicants do not submit additional documents when asked by Sangmyung University, the admission can be revoked.

A. Must achieve at least Grade 3 in TOPIK(Test of Proficiency in Korean) administered by the Korea Institute for Curriculum Evaluation.

(In case of applicants for Arts and Physical Education, they must achieve at least Grade 2 in TOPIK)

B. Must complete at least Grade 4 at the Sangmyung University International Language and Culture Education Center or at the language center of other universities.

(In case of applicants for Arts and Physical Education, they must achieve at least Grade 3)

C. Applicants who have completed at least 2 years of studies at formal four-year universities or applicants who have completed two-year colleges in Korea

B. How to submit Data

The art work must be original work of applicant that is drawn in A3, and performance recorded data must be stored in CD or USB as a file playable by 'Windows Media player'

4. Selection Standard

Successful candidates are selected after considering their ability to learn based on the result on written test (TOPIK), Interview, achievement screening (Arts & Physical Education) and capacity of each academic program.

5. Applicants graduating from foreign or domestic institutions with official agreements with Sangmyung University are selected through a different admission process.

IX. Scholarship and Tuition

1. Scholarship

A. Sangmyung International Student Scholarship(Entrance Scholarship)

- In the first semester, students will be awarded scholarships depending on the admission records
- Amount of scholarship: 100%, 70%, 50%, or 30% of tuition (Entrance fee excluded)

B. Language Excellence Scholarship

- Students with special language abilities will be awarded a scholarship in the first semester.

D. Relocation

Upon change of residence, he/she shall notify the immigration management office within 14 days of moving.

E. Control and Prevention of Illegal Stays

Foreign students who are listed below shall be reported to the immigration management office within 2 weeks to prevent illegal stay.

- 2) Those whose attendance rate is extremely poor and leads to the conclusion that his/her study can not be continued.
- 3) Judged as whose studying purpose is finished due to resigning, being expelled, graduation or missing.

XI. Undergraduate Programs (Departments and Majors)

Division of Area Studies

College of Global Humanities, Division of area study consists 6 different majors(Major in Japanese studies, Major in Chinese studies, Major in English studies, Major in French studies, Major in German studies, Major in Russian studies). All freshmen completes undergraduate curriculum for basic understanding of the various regions of the world and promotion of humanities literacy on their first year, and after that they enter the major course to promote their ability to become an expert of the relevant region. After entering the major courses, in 'language study field' students will learn the advanced language of the region in a step, in 'Region study field' students will learn about the society, culture and history of the region, and in 'Applied Region study field' students will deeply learn the cooperate culture, international relations, political/economical status of the region by method such as an academic seminar.

Major in Japanese studies

In Major in Japanese studies trains students with creative talents who may contribute to social development and exchange od international culture between Korea and Japan in period of modernization of information, internationalization and competition by teaching experties in practical Japanese language, Japanese linguistics and Japanese culture. We produce humanistic intellectuals who are suitable for the era of globalization by exchanging with leading universities in Japan and teaching expertise and practicality of Japanese literature based on various local experience programs.

Major in Chinese studies

China, which achieved remarkable economic growths in the end of 20th century by reform and opening, is achieving sustained economic growth even in 21st century and the external status of China is growing higher day by day. Moreover since economic and cultural exchanges between Korea and China have become more active in recent years, training experts in Chinese studies is very significant both socially and nationally. Major in Chinese studies does our best to train experts who can fluently use Chinese language and carry on the tasks in each field related to China based on a comprehensive knowledge of Chinese history and culture, Chinese political economy and society

Major in English studies

Major in English studies aims to train global experts who has humanistic creativity and professional practical skills based on a command of English language and insight into the culture of English speaking region. After completing the subjects of regional studies and general subjects for training humanities skills for a basic understanding of global communication ability and target region, the course provides academic and practical subjects that improve English proficiency through English use and practice, and also a wide range of subjects covering English literature, English linguistic, English translation, English education, English-speaking regions' culture / geography / society / politics / economics / history. According to the aptitude and the career path of the students, the education based on the Career Road Map (CDR) will be provided and students will acquire professional and practical working ability.

Major in French studies

Major in French studies aims to train students with a wide range of professional knowledge and practical skills in French language proficiency, humanities and French language. Major in French studies covers not only France but also French-speaking countries across the globe such as countries in Europe, Africa and North America. The major offers education of the diverse social and cultural exchanges with the French-speaking countries around the world and the current status of Korean companies in the region. In the area of language studies, students learn French language from the basics to progressive courses encompassing current affairs, business, political economy, and cultural arts. In the area of regional studies, students will learn the humanistic basics of social, cultural and artistic and multi-cultural situations in France, Europe and the French speaking regions. In the area of application of regional studies, the students will carry out deepening study for social advancement and advancement such as study of international relations in French language, economic exchange with France and EU, French language, French cultural contents and culture industry.

Major in German studies

In the 21st century, Germany has emerged as a center of Europe and the world in many aspects such as politics, economy and culture. The spiritual culture of the German language, which has been called the 'country of poets and philosopher', was accepted as an example of modern culture in Korea from early on, and the experiences of overcoming the nation's division, and the sound corporate culture brings us many inspirations to us today. Major in German studies aims to train excellent professionals who can command on German language in everyday and practical affairs and who acquired in-depth knowledge of the culture, history, politics and economy of German speaking countries such as Germany, Austria and Switzerland.

Major in Russian studies

Major in Russian studies is a major that educates various fields such as society, culture, history, economy, diplomacy and etc. of Russia and Russian-speaking Central Asian countries which are emerging in the new international order in the 21st century. Those countries with rich natural resources and a wide market, are newly establishing themselves as close economic and geopolitical partners of Korea in the future. The primary educational objective of this major is to focus on training Russian language skills that are used as official languages in Russia and Central Asia. And based on the language skill, students will acquire various regional knowledge such as social, cultural, historical, political, economic and diplomatic aspects of Russia and Central Asian countries, and will be trained to acquire wide range of geographical literacy that is indispensable for future interactions with the region.

Department of Korean Language and Culture

Department of Korean Language and Culture aims to train creative and reasonable professionals with humanistic character and to train human resources capable of serving the society with expertise in Korean language and culture. By operating major education emphasizing practicality and creativity, the department trains practical professionals who can contribute to the globalization as well as the intrinsic development of Korean language and culture, and who can also provide Korean language cultural contents to advanced information and technological society.

In particular, the centered course contains Korean language courses for foreigners to train talented people who can teach and introduce Korean language and culture to foreigners.

School of Design

School of Design consists of 4 specific majors: Major in Visual Communication, Major in Fashion Design, Major in Interior Design, and Major in Ceramic Design. The curriculum consists of university policy liberal arts education and undergraduate basic design education, and students choose their major field of study that meet their needs from their second year. Based on the educational philosophy of Culture + Human + Emotion + Strategy, School of Design aims to train global design leaders with international senses, creative design leaders leading the knowledge-based information society, and multi-functional design leaders required by the nation. Also School of Design pursues the vision of the revival of the design industry by training the next generation of design leaders that encompass creative design, professional technique, and design management reflecting the modern design paradigm.

Major in Visual Communication

Major in Visual Communication is a major that teaches methods and techniques for visualizing various information and messages and delivering them to users effectively. This major educates a wide range of areas from offline (editing, typography, graphic design, information design, brand design, illustration) to online (mobile, web, app, game, UI, UX, BX). The second year students will study the fundamentals and principles necessary for visual design, and the third and fourth graders will be provided professional education to demonstrate their leadership in the industrial field through practical education through deepening and developing their majors. In addition, through international exchange with foreign universities and industry-university-affiliated programs, Major in Visual Communication trains design experts with highly specialized and international competitiveness.

Major in Fashion Design

Major in Fashion Design aims to train professionals with creative and sensuous aesthetic sense that leads the high value-added fashion industry in a diverse and specialized social structure of modern society. Major in Fashion Design focuses on educating fashion professionals with creative intelligence by providing education of theoretical study, innovative design and planning ability of fashion design, and also by providing various practical subjects that can build professional clothes and production ability.

Major in Interior Design

Major in Interior Design is the first major in Korea to establish bachelor course of interior design. This major studies and teaches the design of the internal space of a building that is directly related to human living lives. In Major in Interior Design, full-time professors who majored in design and construction, and the instructors with professional knowledge and practical experiences are constantly developing educational systems to train creative interior designers with an international sense. Through this education, students majoring in this major have been awarded the top prize in the main contests in Korea, and after graduation they are evaluated as excellent in their ability to adapt from their career directors.

Major in Ceramic Design

Major in Ceramic Design aims at the fusion education that realizes ceramic design as product based on understanding of creative thinking ability, problem solving method and various ceramic technology. Through the education, students will acquire practical knowledge and experience to become the leaders of the next generation of ceramic design field by

acquiring strategic planning ability, design capability based on ceramic technology, and business management ability. After graduation, students will be able to choose variety of career paths such as leader in the ceramic industry, product planning and strategy manager in the ceramic industry, creative director in the living life industry, and director of product design and development in related industries.

Department of Textile Design

Textile design is the process of transforming various patterns and using techniques into fabrics that are the closest to human life and converting them into fabric suitable for use. The department aims to educate textile designers who have the qualities to systematically study these design processes and to create valuable fabrics that fulfill diverse consumer's needs.

The department provide education of the design process of textile materials, various techniques and textile product planning by subdividing the subject by weaving, dyeing, knitting, pattern design, and material planning to understand various means of expression using textiles and textiles. Each subjects are organically interconnected to develop infinite possibilities of expression depending on the individual's capabilities. Based on the knowledge and experience gained through the curriculum, and by learning the realism and technical sense of the field, students can become the creative textile designers and textile experts who will lead the future of the Korean textile industry

Department of Industrial Design

The Department of Industrial Design aims to train creative design leaders of the next generation, and focuses on the development of creative design talents by establishing the specialization training of advanced information culture and design along with design theory and technical education necessary for various industries. The department focuses on differential design education which can provide creative problem solving ability based on systematic design detailed education process such as design research, analysis, practice, evaluation / review with education conditions such as design theory, practice, and field learning. The Department of Industrial Design, which always leads the development of culture in accordance with the needs and expectations of society, has an innovative educational system that accepts new technologies quickly and reflects them in education, and provides education that trains students to acquire comprehensive design skills required to grow as a future-oriented professional design leader in the future.

Department of Theatre, Film, and Arts Management

Department of Theatre, Film, and Arts Management consists of 3 specific majors: Film and Media Major, Theatre Arts Major, and Arts and Cultural Managements Major. The future-oriented high-tech film industry, which invests a large amount of capital to create enormous added value, is attracting attention as a combination of information and communication technology and the Korean wave enthusiast that captures the whole world. Film and Media Major trains professional staffs in the field of film and video and a variety of image content personnel. Theatre Arts Major consists of 2 specific tracks(Theory, Acting) and focuses on training theatre professionals who will lead the 21st century by operating the stage-by-stage performance production classes, and assigning suitable instructors and curriculums for each track. Arts and Cultural Managements Major provides systematic knowledge, skills, and qualities that are needed by arts and crafts managers through theory and practice, and trains competent personnel for cultural and artistic planning and management that will lead the Korean culture field by carrying out competency-based education.

Film and Media Major

Film is an art that instills dreams of the future based on human creativity and imagination. It is also a kind of future-oriented industry that creates huge added value with large-scale capital investments. In nowadays digital film has become very popular due to the integration of information and communication technologies. In accordance to this nature of film, Film and Media Major trains talented professionals who will lead the future of advanced film art and film industry. Considering the fact that the cultural, artistic and industrial values of film and media are getting higher, Film and Media Major operates high level of theoretical education on film and media. And also the major trains talented individuals with practical skills by offering practical education in various fields such as directing, shooting, and acting which are necessary for creating a movie or media content.

Theatre Arts Major

Theatre Arts Major focuses on training theatrical professionals who will lead the 21st century. The major aims to train intellect and sensibility to be equipped as a theater person by operating practical training based on theoretical course, and to educate theatrical professionals with virtue and personality that can demonstrate his skills as an artist through stage-based performance production classes in each grade years.

Arts and Cultural Managements Major

Arts and Cultural Managements Major aims to contribute to the promotion of culture and arts, the growth of creative industries, and the promotion of cultural welfare of the people by training culture, art, planning and management professionals who will lead the Korean culture in the creative culture-based economy era. For that Arts and Cultural Managements Major operates competency - based education systematically provided through theory and practice that will offer Knowledge, skill, attitude, and knowledge that demanded to culture-arts managements professionals.

Department of Photography and Media Contents

Department of Photography and Media Contents is a department that will be the prospective leader of the art and cultural contents industry which was newly established by the merging of the Department of Photography & Media and the Department of Digital Contents. The department aims to develop scientific thinking and creative thinking according to the time concept of photography and image contents and to educate aesthetic modeling sense. For that, to offer creativity, technique and various skills that can only be obtained at the industrial site, the department provides combination of various theoretical and practical lessons, and operates internship programs cooperating with industry. Because Department of Photography and Media Contents educates core field of the modern industry, which is a new field of study combining traditional art, creativity, knowledge and technology, the department can train highly versatile professionals with storytelling and planning skills to create innovative ideas by operating basic curriculum but also subjects based on fusion of art and knowledge information. For that, Department of Photography and Media Contents sets up main tracks such as photographs, video contents, and edutainment contents, and organizes a systematic learning system for each track to operate the curriculum.

Department of Theatre Art & Design

Sangmyung University' s Department of Theatre Art & Design was established in 1996 as the first bachelor course in Korea, and the department produced a lot of talented professionals in fields of performing arts such as theater, dance,

opera, musical, broadcasting, film, and art. The department is operates fusion art education program specified into stage design, stage costume and dress design, stage lighting and sound design, production design, and pure art. This educational system became the foundation of the academic foundation and the standard of Korean stage art and technology study. Sangmyung University' s Department of Theatre Art & Design aims to train responsible artists who will lead the future culture by developing creative value of artists, and to provide ethical professionals who have technical and academic competencies.

Department of Cartoon and Animation

Department of Cartoon and Animation operates a professional manpower training centered on cartoon and animation major. The Cartoon Major teaches the whole process of making cartoons from planning, story, continuity, to editing. It offers in addition to planning, training to create comic works from the setting of the character in the story to the production method. Also in order to concentrate on training high-tech culture arts professionals who can lead the changing multimedia environment, Cartoon Major is strengthening new technology based lessons such as game planning / graphic and interactive contents based on cartoon contents, and aims to train professionals who will lead new era of 21st century cartoon through various international exchanges and collaborative projects. The Animation Major has an integrated curriculum operating platform for each grade that takes into consideration practical work on basic education so that it can adapt well to rapidly changing industrial field. The Animation Major students will be able to work in the variety of related industries after graduation such as production and planning of 2D / 3D game and various media correspondence animation, Character Design for Animation, Game, Movie, Background Art, Special Effects, Character Figure Production, independent animation creator, and APP contents that is recently appearing.

Department of Cartoon and Animation provides the combination of theoretical and practical education. The department utilizes and operates complex theories and basic theories of visual arts ranging from paintings, visuals, to photographs. Based on this education the department aims to train creative talents that will lead the future fusion culture industry with international competitiveness by widening the possibility of industry-university cooperation through practical multi-disciplinary curriculum

Department of Global Finance Management

Department of Global Finance Management is a reorganized department from Department of Finance & Insurance(established in 1989) in 2017 to flexibly respond to changing business environment. Based on the past 27 years of history, the department aims to train professionals with globalization, innovation and leadership that are required in the 21st century global business environment through new leaps and bounds. The department objects to provide education of various management techniques and theories that supports economists to survive and develop in uncertain times like nowadays, and to provide practical education that enables to solve problems by applying theory to the field. Currently the department provides education programs in the fields of general management, finance, insurance and accounting, and plans to gradually expand the education into marketing, management strategies, and human resources management. As a result of strong demand-oriented education, many alumni are active in the fields of finance and insurance, domestic companies with potentials and foreign companies. Students and their parents' are very satisfied by the results of high employment rate and the fact that most students are employed in the field of industry associated with their major.

Department of Plant and Food Science

Department of Plant and Food Science deals with the plant food industry such as the development, production, utilization and processing of plants. The Plant and Food Science consists of three fields. The field of Development is a field of creation and dissemination of new plants, including biotechnology, breeding, and tissue culture. The field of production includes facilities and control fields necessary for production technology and production of applied plants. The field of utilize is a field of storing, processing and distributing the developed and produced applied plants. Because Department of Plant and Food Science pursues industrial applications based on information on applicable plants and foods, logical thinking ability to systematically study the basic and application knowledge and skills of natural sciences are required. Department of Plant and Food Science is a department that requires logical thinking ability to systematically integrate relevant knowledge and skills of natural and social sciences, and the department aims to train global leaders in the future plant and food industry that are aiming at the development and industrialization of plants and foods using biotechnology and information technology in the fields of plants and food industries, where values for environment and health are highlighted.

Department of Environment & Landscape Architecture

Based on the Green Technology, the Department of Environmental Landscape Architecture provides the education of macro ecological engineering such as urban planning / architecture / landscaping / public design / environmental design / environmental impact assessment / environmental ecological restoration / and environmental ecological planning, and also provides the education of planning, designing and constructing outdoor spaces and facilities that meet in everyday life such as urban gardens / urban gardening / rooftop greening / street trees / landscape design / street facilities / children's play facilities. The department aims to train creative talents through three-dimensional learning methods such as theory, field practice, and practical training. The department was selected as 'CK, University for Creative Korea' by Ministry of Education in year 2014 and is capable of supporting 'CK Scholarship' to students and students can acquire 1 professional qualifications every year and as a result they can obtain 3 or 4 qualifications before the graduation. In addition, the department is actively engaged in on-the-job training and internship training that is linked to the companies in related industries, and to fulfill the 100% employment of graduates, the department operates career program such as corporate mentoring system that offers students experience of various career planning and practicing programs. Also the department collaborates with Department of Civil Engineering to operate interdisciplinary program 'Major in Ecology Convergence Design Engineering'. This allows from 1st graders to 4th graders to be awarded not only a Bachelor of Science of Environmental of Landscape Architecture major but also they can be awarded a Bachelor of Engineering of Ecology Convergence Design Engineering major.

School of Convergence Sports

School of Convergence Sports consists of two major majors: Major in Sports Management and Major in Lifetime Sports & Leisure. The curriculum consists of university's liberal arts education and undergraduate basic education, and students can choose their specific major in their second semester of first year, and study chosen major course from the second grade. School of Convergence Sports aims to train global sports leaders with an international sense, convergent leaders who will lead a knowledge-based information society, and professional practitioners who can meet social demands based on cultivating humanity, professionalism and convergence ability. The recent interest in the sports industries has led to a new paradigm shift and augmentation of various sports infrastructures. In accordance with this social atmosphere, it is necessary to provide education for enhancing global job performance by integrating education with other studies to provide professional manpower who are required in the high value-added sports field.

Therefore based on the educational philosophy of fostering convergent and practical talents with global capabilities, School of Convergence Sports aims to train next generation sports leaders with creativity and expertise to Understand and Perform 21st Century Sports.

Major in Sports Management

The changes in awareness of sports and the increase in participation due to the improvement of people's standard of living have led to the transformation of paradigm of sports major field and promoted the increase of various sports infrastructures. In accordance with this social atmosphere, it is very urgent to train professional manpower in various fields required in high value-added sports field. Therefore Major in Sports Management aims to educate students who will lead the Korean sports industry after graduation with practical skills connected with other disciplines and theoretical and practical skills related to various sports fields through operation of various educational programs and various sports R & D and academic projects.

Major in Lifetime Sports & Leisure

Major in Lifetime Sports & Leisure aims to train social sports instructor, exercise prescription and sports rehabilitation specialist, health education specialist, sports administration and management specialist to fulfill the goal of physical education that is to foster healthy and competent societies and democratic citizens through physical activities and sports. There are a variety of professors in the field of social and physical education, exercise prescription rooms with advanced scientific equipments, laboratories such as motion analysis room and sports rehabilitation room, gymnasium with latest equipment and equipment, soccer field with night lighting facilities, tennis court, Squash courts, basketball courts and other training.

Department of Electronics Engineering

Department of Electronics Engineering is a core department of Sangmyung university's 'Program for Industrial needs-Matched Education' that aims to educate professionals with the ability to utilize and control the hardware in the fields of electricity, electronics, computers and software. The department develops professions of electronic system hardware and related software development ability by providing education that is based on combination of academic foundation through theory and practical basics through laboratory practice. The students learn various programming languages such as C, C++ and JAVA as well as basic theories such as electronic circuits and digital systems, and learn various application techniques such as internet, embedded system, computer vision, and mobile software. The department works on various practical training programs such as field work projects, internships, expert seminars, and CEO lectures and also operates a Graduate school laboratory to study software detailed technology. Department of Software was selected as a 'Program for Industrial needs-Matched Education' department by Ministry of Education and receives support fund of 5 billion KRW annually, therefore has the sufficient support and suitable condition to provide excellent education to train workforce.

Department of Smart Information and Telecommunication Engineering

Department of Smart Information and Telecommunication Engineering is a leading department of Sangmyung university's 'Program for Industrial needs-Matched Education'. The department was selected as an excellent department and received support fund of 'CK, University for Creative Korea' by Ministry of Education in year 2015 and 2016. The department trains core workforce who are required in internet and telecommunication(Commonly referred as "Smart Devices") industry which is Korea's core industry. One computer per student is supported for experimental education environment and the department operates 6 credit program major education that completes theoretical learning by practical exercises. Department of Management Engineering

In the past most problems were solvable with a single technique or theory by specialist in single specific field, but in nowadays there are many complicated problems that only experts with various fields of knowledge and experience can provide clues to solve the problems. Department of Management Engineering trains and provides professional workforce who are capable of solving the inefficiency and optimization problem of operation that has been traditionally pursued in the field of industrial engineering, and who can resolve various management difficulties in financial services, public institutions, and government systems more efficiently. For that Department of Management Engineering trains students to acquire business knowledge, engineering knowledge and business mind by focusing on educating in fields of marketing, production management, financial engineering, management science, and service management.

Department of Green Chemical Engineering

Based on traditional chemical engineering, Department of Green Chemical Engineering provides focused education in field of environmental, renewable energy and biotechnology related subjects that determine the quality of life of mankind. The department aims to foster chemical engineering engineers with in-depth expertise and excellent working abilities that can play a pivotal role in the specialized chemical industry.
